You do not need to submit a cover sheet with amended papers. Failure to file a cover sheet with the first paper filed in a civil case may subject a party, its counsel, or both to sanctions under rules 201.8(c) and 227 of the California Rules of Court.

To Parties in Complex Cases

In complex cases only, parties must also use the Civil Case Cover Sheet to designate whether the case is complex. If a plaintiff believes the case is complex under rule 1800 of the California Rules of Court, this must be indicated by completing the appropriate boxes in items 1 and 2. If a plaintiff designates a case as complex, the cover sheet must be served with the complaint on all parties to the action. A defendant may file and serve no later than the time of its first appearance a joinder in the plaintiff's designation, a counter-designation that the case is not complex, or, if the plaintiff has made no designation, a designation that the case is complex.

- 6. During the course of Lynch's employment and up until the time Cohen discovered Lynch's deceit, Cohen had developed a strong sense of respect for Lynch's professional capabilities and trusted her to handle many aspects of his life so that he could spend more time focusing on his creative and other personal endeavors. As such, Lynch maintained in her possession many files and other items that belonged to Cohen for that purpose.
- 7. Although Lynch was terminated an entire year ago, she is wrongfully holding and detaining items of Cohen's personal property to which he has an immediate right of possession. These items include but are not limited to the following:
 - (a) Mr. Cohen's personal correspondence in the form of handwritten letters and facsimiles dating from 1960 to approximately 1995, including but not limited to correspondence with Dominique Issermann, Burt Goldstein, and Herschel Weinberg, Esq.;
 - (b) Mr. Cohen's business correspondence dating from 1980 to 2004;
 - (c) a notebook of original watercolor drawings created by Mr. Cohen;
 - (d) Mr. Cohen's personal journals from 1960 to 1990, which contain his drawings, sketches, lyrics, poems, and other writings;
 - (e) Mr. Cohen's personal financial records from 1980 to 2004, such as tax returns, bank statements, and other receipts and documents; and
 - (f) the original manuscript of one of Mr. Cohen's novels, "Beautiful Losers."
- 8. Cohen demanded that Lynch return the above-listed property before this action was filed, but Lynch has refused to do so.
 - 9. Given the personal nature of this property, no specific value may be attributed to it.

WHEREFORE, Cohen prays for judgment against Lynch as follows:

- 1. For an order stating that Cohen is entitled to immediate possession of the abovelisted property and directing the clerk to issue a writ of possession;
 - 2. For reasonable attorneys' fees;
 - 3. For costs of this suit; and
 - 4. For such other and further relief as the Court deems to be just and appropriate.

Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, Central District NOTICE OF CASE ASSIGNMENT

The following critical provisions of the Chapter 7 Rules as applicable in the Central District are summarized for your assistance.

APPLICATION

The Chapter 7 Rules were effective January 1, 1994. They apply to all general civil cases.

PRIORITY OVER OTHER RULES

The Chapter 7 Rules shall have priority over all other Local Rules to the extent the others are inconsistent.

CHALLENGE TO ASSIGNED JUDGE

A challenge under Code of Civil Procedure Section 170.6 must be made within 15 days after notice of assignment for all purposes to a judge, or if a party has not yet appeared, within 15 days of the first appearance.

TIME STANDARDS

Cases assigned to the Individual Calendaring Court will be subject to processing under the following time standards:

COMPLAINTS: All complaints shall be served within 60 days of filing and proof of service shall be filed within 90 days of filing.

CROSS-COMPLAINTS: Without leave of court first being obtained, no cross-complaint may be filed by any party after their answer is filed. Cross-complaints shall be served within 30 days of the filing date and a proof of service filed within 60 days of the filing date.

A Status Conference will be scheduled by the assigned I/.C Judge no later than 270 days after the filing of the complaint. Counsel must be fully prepared to discuss the following issues: alternative dispute resolution, bifurcation, settlement, trial_date and expert witnesses.

FINAL STATUS CONFERENCE

The Court will require the parties at a status conference not more than 10 days prior to the trial to have timely filed and served all motions in limine, bifurcation motions, statements of major evidentiary issues, dispositive motions, requested jury instructions and special jury instructions and special jury verdicts; so that such matters may be heard and resolved at this conference. At least 5 days prior to this conference, counsel must also have exchanged lists of exhibits and witnesses and have submitted to the court a brief statement of the case to be read to the jury panel as required by Chapter Eight of the Los Angeles Superior Court Rules.

SANCTIONS

The court will impose appropriate sanctions for the failure or refusal to comply with Chapter 7 Rules, orders made by the Court, and time standards or deadlines established by the Court or by the Chapter 7 Rules. Such sanctions may be on a party or if appropriate on counsel for such party.

This is not a complete delineation of the Chapter 7 Rules, and adherence only to the above provisions is therefore not a guarantee against the imposition of sanctions under Trial Court Delay Reduction. Careful reading and compliance with the actual Chapter Rules is absolutely imperative.

*Class Actions

All class actions are initially assigned to Judge Victoria Chaney in Department 324 of the Central Civil West courthouse (600 S. Commonwealth St., Los Angeles 90005). This assignment is for pretrial purposes and for the purpose of assessing whether or not the case is complex within the meaning of California Rules of Court 1800 et seq. Depending on the outcome of that assessment, the class action case may be reassigned to one of the judges of the Complex Litigation Program or reassigned randomly to a court in the Central District.
